Important Safety Update From Michlig AgriCenter

Our 2010 Summer Fill will begin soon and it is a good time to review Propane Safety. During our summer fill we will be checking for leaks on tanks, lines and regulators. Enclosed with this letter is a pamphlet that everyone should take to heart concerning propane safety.

The following are just a few items to consider that are not covered in the pamphlet: **Regulators: It is required by our Insurance Company that every 15 years we change out your regulators.** If your regulators need to be replaced we will be contacting you to schedule a time to switch them. They are finding that in some cases the regulators fail, which could result in over or under pressurization of the system or a gas leak. The regulators are located on the tank itself and also where the gas line enters the house. The cost is minor when you consider the problems that could occur.

DON'T RUN OUT OF GAS! Serious safety hazards, including fire or explosion, can result.

If an appliance valve or a gas line is left open, a leak could occur when the system is recharged with propane- If your propane tank runs out of gas any pilot lights on your appliances will go out. This can be extremely dangerous. • A LEAK CHECK IS REQUIRED, A qualified service technician must perform a leak check of your propane system before turning on the gas. If you run out of propane there will be a \$100.00 service charge to perform this test and relight pilots. If you are a Keep Full customer and you run out, it's our mistake and these charges do not apply.

Normal Business Hours Are 7:00am to 4:00pm Monday thru Friday If you are not currently on our Keep Full route and you want to be added to our list please call and let us know and we will make sure you never run out of gas during the winter!! *If you're not sure if you are on the Keep Full list please call to verify.*

The Most Important Thing to remember is that if you smell a leak inside or outside your house, don't hesitate to contact Michlig AgriCenter, your safety is very important to us.
